A start up incubated by our college incubation and entrepreneurship cell has guided the young entrepreneurs of Future Tech who manage our computerized fee receipt, roll call data generation along with a unique code provided to every student admitted to our Institution. A student is tagged with this unique code for examination, along with his subjects. The data is linked to the examination section for mark sheets, results and provisional passing certificate from UG to PG. Online student enrolment and eligibility for entry level UG and PG classes and generation of transfer certificate online is done through MKCL portal. The student attendance and SMS alerts are sent through the online services of FRUGAL solutions wherein the Identity card which have RFID is used for marking attendance and reports are generated online. The library and Information services are automated using SOUL software. Books being bar coded enables easy stock. Online examination solutions are provided by Tech catalyst. Employers can verify the student documents like mark sheets online through e verify. Placements are managed online through calyx pod. Project management to a certain extent is done through Trello. Accounts are managed through Tally. Payroll management is done through Sensys. Salaries are generated online through HTE Sevarth a Maharashtra Government Initiative.</p>

• The entire function of the college is based on two pillars of trust and participative management. We firmly believe in empowering the members of teaching and non teaching staff and are also decision makers as and when required. The Principal is ably supported by four Vice Principal, Head of the Departments, Senior and new recruits. Two practices of decentralisation and participative management during the last year are as follows: • Every department has its own Board of studies which is constituted as per UGC norms the curriculum designed is approved by appropriate statutory body and implemented by the departments which chalks out the teaching plan and implementation of the curriculum. Students also are well informed so they can plan their vacations. It also allows family members to plan their family events. Teachers prepare teaching plan so as to ensure proper delivery of content to the learners. E resource has been made available to the learner to encourage self learning. In autonomy, 40 internal and 60 external pattern of evaluation is adopted. 40 internal evaluation include multiple choice questions, assignments, presentations, seminars, quiz, projects with focus on learner and 60 external evaluation by mean of subjective test. Several other remarkable reforms implemented at institutional level are : allotment of unique code to every students so that performance and individual student can be easily traces , masking of answer sheets for maintaining the confidentiality of the learner , moderation by external moderators, feedback from moderators for quality improvement , secured features on the mark list, extra credits on qualifying semester to students excelling well and dedicating appreciable amount of time in academic and nonacademic activities ,remedial learning for weak students.

Research and Development

The research committee chalks out programmes for motivating staff and students to undertake research projects. Guest speakers are invited who deliver lectures on frontiers in research in various subjects. Students and staff are encourage to present their work at various forums like seminars, conferences and research festival of affiliating University known as Avishkar. Online journals are subscribed and made available to researchers. The staff and students are provided with information on various funding agencies and the proposals are processed in time. The funds received are utilised properly and audited statement of accounts are submitted to funding agencies every year. All infrastructural facilities are provided to encourage research.

There is regular up gradation of infrastructure. All facilities are maintained through annual maintenance contracts given to various agencies. In house engineers, carpenters, electrician, mason, plumbers ensure that any wear and tear is taken care of immediately.
